EM funding balance 2021: BMDV invests in over 1,000 e-vehicles and around 250 charging points

The Federal Ministry for Digital and Transport (BMDV) is investing another 20 million euros for the procurement of vehicles and development of charging infrastructure under the Electric Mobility Funding Guideline. A total of 86 projects will be approved, 36 of which will be proposed by municipalities and 50 by companies. The BMDV is supporting the procurement of more than 1,000 vehicles and almost 250 charging points under the Electric Mobility Funding Guideline ...

Market test results on BMDV funding of electricity-based kerosene available

With the successful completion of a market test on structuring funding design, the Federal Ministry for Digital and Transport (BMDV) is paving the way for the market ramp-up of electricity-based liquid fuels (power-to-liquid, PTL). A total of 16 project outlines from all over Germany were received as part of the test, the call for which was issued by the BMDV in August 2021. The focus of the funding will be on the production of PTL kerosene, as there is still a lack of climate-neutral alternative technologies, particularly in the aviation sector ...
