New fuel cell buses for Bielefeld

During the course of the next few weeks, Bielefeld's public transport company moBiel will be putting the first nine of a total of 25 new fuel cell buses into operation. The vehicles, which include eight 12-meter buses and seventeen 18-meter (articulated) eCitaro Fuelcell buses, can be powered by both hydrogen and electricity. They each have a range of over 400 kilometers, making them easy to use on all scheduled routes in the bus network ...
