The Deutschlandnetz continues to grow: Mer Germany opens charging park with PV roof in Künzelsau

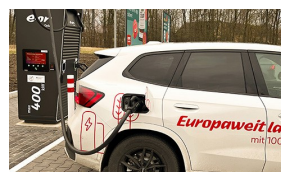
